We recognize that two-thirds of the total tax cuts were caused by reducing the top income tax rate from 6.65 to 5.0 percent. These cuts provided minimal or no benefit to middle and lower income Oklahomans; and

WHEREAS:

We recognize that Oklahoma State and Local Taxes are among the lowest in the nation as a percentage of Personal Income. We recognize that the Oklahoma Tax System is regressive which means the poor pay a greater portion of their income than do the rich assuming all taxes are counted, including income, sales, and property tax; and

WHEREAS:

We recognize that the greatest benefits from the income tax cuts go to the top 20% of income earning households; and

WHEREAS:

We recognize that the gross production tax on oil and gas production is declining because of tax credits to producers. In fact, the gross production tax has been reduced; and

WHEREAS:

We recognize that state budgets have been cut sharply in recent years when adjusted for inflation, and in particular, funding for public education and higher education is declining; and

WHEREAS:

We recognize that our income tax rate tops out at \$24,900 of income for a married person (changes with inflation). That means if a married taxpayer gets to that level, they do not pay any greater percentages of their income more than 5%; and

WHEREAS:

We recognize that our opponents used false information to mislead the public and to hide and misinform about our dysfunctional tax system. Basically, our current tax system takes away benefits from the needy and rewards the greedy. Robin Hood in reverse;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

We support and applaud the bipartisan tax analysis done by the Oklahoma Policy Institute and recommend that people learn more about tax analysis through okpolicy.org.

In the 2016 landmark decision Whole Woman's Health v. Hellerstedt, the Supreme Court reaffirmed a woman's constitutional right to access safe, legal abortion, confirming more than 40 years of precedent; and

WHEREAS:

A woman's right to access safe, legal abortion without burdensome restrictions imposed by a state is at stake across the country; and

WHEREAS:

Oklahoma has some of the most restrictive abortion laws in the country. A patient must receive state-directed counseling that includes information designed to discourage the patient from having an abortion, and then wait 72 hours before the procedure is provided. Patient's must also undergo an ultrasound before obtaining an abortion and the use of telemedicine to administer medication abortion is prohibited; and

WHEREAS:

In 2021 Oklahoma's Republican-controlled Legislature sponsored more than a dozen abortion bills to further restrict abortion access to Oklahoma women, including one bill that would classify abortion as homicide. That measure would have punished not only physicians performing abortions, but also patients who undergo the procedure. Fortunately, this hideous bill was unanimously rejected in committee; and

WHEREAS:

The conservative assault on a woman's right to choose has been emboldened by the shifting political makeup of the Supreme Court and various state courts—including the Oklahoma Supreme Court—and will continue and become more restrictive; and

WHEREAS:

Everyone should have access to comprehensive health care in the state of Oklahoma.

American families are struggling to pay for health care, food, housing, childcare and other basic needs, and breadwinners desperately need a raise. Additionally, the ability to meet basic needs becomes more difficult when wages are stagnant as the cost of living continues to increase; and

WHEREAS:

The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) produces two inflation measures used to adjust parameters for federal benefit programs including the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) and the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U); and WHEREAS:

Several major federal benefit programs are indexed for inflation including the cost-of-living adjustments for Social Security, income eligibility for Medicaid, income and asset benefits for Medicare, and most benefit programs serving retired and disabled veterans; and

WHEREAS:

When business owners invest in their workers by giving them fair wages, workers are likely to spend or save more of their bigger paychecks, and in the process, stimulate the economy and create new jobs. Additionally, fair wage and compensation packages promote long-term employment and reduce the amount of time and money businesses spend on training and retraining employees; and

WHEREAS:

Raising the minimum wage would be transformative for women and families. According to analysis by the Economic Policy Institute (EPI) and the National Employment Law Project (NELP), the majority of workers who would benefit from gradually raising the federal minimum wage to \$15 an hour are women—59 percent, or nearly 19 million. In total, more than 1 in 4 working women, both those working full and part time, would see a raise; and

WHEREAS:

Women, on average, are paid \$0.82 for every dollar paid to men and many women of color are paid even less. Data shows that an increase in pay for low-wage workers could have a significant impact on the gender and racial pay gap; and

WHEREAS:

President Joe Biden's plan to "Build Back Better" for American workers includes raising the minimum wage to \$15 per hour and ending the tipped minimum wage and sub-minimum wage for people with disabilities. Additionally, Congressional Democrats have reintroduced the Raise the Wage Act, which would increase the federal minimum wage from \$7.25 per hour to \$15.00 per hour by 2025.
